Scholarships will be awarded based on the applicant's scholastic achievement, financial need, and personal qualities such as character and leadership ability.

Each scholarship, which will be at least \$500, will be paid to the school at which the applicant enrolls with instructions for disbursement and monitoring. In the event the recipient does not matriculate, or drops out, any unused funds in possession of the school shall be returned to the respective Scholarship Fund.

Scholarship applications are reviewed by a panel of professional educators not affiliated with The Associates Foundation, who will select the recipients. Recipients will be notified in July and funds will be sent by mid-August for fall registration.

Applicants must meet the following requirements to be eligible for the scholarship:

### 1) ASSOCIATES FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

- a) Applicant must be a <u>dependent child of an employee or contractor of a Federal agency located in the Pacific Northwest/Bonneville Power's Service Territory</u> at the time of application (include evidence of parent or guardian's 2023 employment), or <u>a child of a deceased employee or contractor</u>. If there are no qualified dependent child applicants, an employee or contractor and/or their spouse may be considered.
- b) Applicant plans to enroll full-time in an undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited 4-year college/university or a 2-year college in a program leading to an academic degree.
- c) Applicant must demonstrate that they have met matriculation requirements of the school at which they intend to enroll.
- d) Applicant must have a good behavioral background, and genuine interest and sincerity in seeking additional education.
- e) Applicant need not be a high school graduate, but must have a high school diploma or GED equivalent.
- f) All other factors being equal, priority will be given to applicants 22 years of age or younger.

The Associates Foundation Scholarship is administered by The Associates Foundation with funding support from 'The Associates' and donations solicited by the Associates Foundation. The scholarship amount ranges from \$500 to \$1,500 depending upon available funds.

### 2) JOANN JETER MEMORIAL DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

- a) Applicant is from a diverse background (examples: first-generation college student, cultural and/or ethnic background, low-income, or other clearly articulated aspect of diversity as presented in your essay).
- b) Applicant must demonstrate that they have met matriculation requirements of the school at which they plan to enroll.
- c) Applicant is planning to enroll full-time in an undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited 4-year college/university, or a 2-year college enrolled in a program leading to an academic degree.

The JoAnn Jeter Memorial Diversity Scholarship is administered by the Associates Foundation in collaboration with the Jeter Family. Initial funding was established by private donation.. The scholarship amount will range from \$500 to \$1,000.

### 3) DICK FRENCH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- a) Applicant is at least ¼ American Indian/Alaskan Native and/or is a recognized member of a federally-recognized Tribe.
- b) Applicant is a student member of American Indian Science and Engineering Society (AISES).
- c) Applicant plans to enroll in a full-time undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited 4-year college/university or at a 2-year college enrolled in a program leading to an academic degree.
- d) Applicant must demonstrate that they have met matriculation requirements of the school at which they plan to enroll.
- e) Applicant is planning to major in a discipline relating to the environment such as Biology, Forestry, Natural Resource Management, Chemistry, Entomology, Environmental Science, Hydrology, or related disciplines.
- f) Applicant is a resident of Oregon, Washington, or Idaho.

The Dick French Memorial Scholarship is administered by and funded by the AISES Lower Columbia/Willamette River Professional Chapter. The scholarship amount is \$500.
